GIVING BACK TO VIRGINIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS

In Fiscal Year 2023, the Virginia Lottery had sales of more than \$4.6 billion. Of this total, the Lottery generated more than \$867 million for K-12 public education; more than \$3.4 billion went back to players in the form of prizes, more than \$137 million went to the retailers who sell Virginia Lottery tickets, and \$195 million went to operational expenses.

Since 1999, all Virginia Lottery profits have been used for K-12 public education in Virginia. On this page, you can find the breakdown of historical Lottery sales figures. Below that data, you can see how much of the FY2023 profits were given to each public-school division in Virginia.

When Virginians voted in 1987 for a state-operated lottery, some people may have assumed that they voted on how to spend the Lottery's proceeds. This was not the case. Lottery proceeds were to be used as determined by the General Assembly. The use of the proceeds has changed over time. In 1989, Lottery proceeds were dedicated to capital-construction projects. From 1990 to 1998, Lottery proceeds were transferred to the state's General Fund. Starting in 1999, a state budget amendment sent Lottery proceeds to local public-school divisions to be used solely for educational purposes. In 2000, more than 80% of Virginia voters said yes to the creation of the State Lottery Proceeds Fund. The measure, now a permanent part of Virginia's Constitution, directs all Virginia Lottery profits to be used solely for educational purposes.

The Virginia Lottery was establishing in 1988 and is a 400-employee independent agency of the Commonwealth of Virginia constitutionally created to benefit K-12 public education. In 2020, the Lottery was tasked with additional responsibilities regulating land-based casinos and mobile sports betting. In FY23, Virginia Lottery sold over \$4.6 billion in products, bringing in profits of more than \$876 million for K-12 public education. Our Gaming Compliance division oversees regulation, licensing, auditing, and compliance for three land-based casinos and 16 mobile sports betting operators. The Executive Director provides leadership to the dual roles of the Lottery as both a business enterprise and regulatory agency.

Responsibilities

- Manage a lottery leadership team comprised of Directors that oversee sales, marketing, finance, human resources, information technology, cybersecurity, public relations, audit, administration, and security
 - Steer omnichannel strategy to grow lottery sales at 5,300 retail locations and online through the web and app
 - Serve as a member on national lottery organizations that oversee the implementation of jackpot games and work with industry associations to share best practices
- Manage a gaming compliance leadership team comprised of licensing, gaming technology, compliance, and audit
 - Direct mission and goals to ensure the highest levels of transparency and accountability from gaming operators, equipment manufacturers and distributors, supplies, and onsite casino employees
 - Oversee enforcement of all regulatory violations and necessary sanctioning
- Engage with the Lottery Board to provide recommendations on regulatory action and approval of the annual official forecast of lottery sales included in the state budget
- Liaise with government officials and legislators to offer input on policy departments and constituent issues


